Health & Safety Protocols

The health and safety of our Children, Staff, and Families has always been our top priority. Each of our schools is operating in accordance and with all CDC, OEC, State & Local Health Department safety precautions and practices. The current pandemic situation has reinforced the importance of taking every available precaution so we have implemented many practices which go above and beyond the requirements of government authorities.

Here is what we are doing to make sure your children stay safe and healthy:

- All children and child care staff are being checked prior to entering the program for any observable illness, including cough or respiratory distress, and to confirm temperature below 100F.
- All staff and children must adhere to regular handwashing with soap and water for at least 20 seconds.
- Access to the facility is limited: One parent is allowed in the building at a time. Please do not pass the sign-in desk. Parents are encouraged to call 5 mins prior to your arrival and a staff member will have your child ready.
- Class sizes are restricted to 10 or fewer children at a time.
- Increased cleaning and disinfection practices have been implemented.
- Use of electrostatic disinfectant sprayers at each center to effectively disinfect equipment and surfaces.

We are taking every precaution to keep your child safe while they are in our care. But, we need your help! By practicing the following at home, you can do your part to keep us all safe and healthy:

- Keep children showing signs of sickness home.
- Frequently clean and disinfect high-touch areas.
- Practice and teach children good hygiene and frequent handwashing.
- We ask parents to ONLY send in essential items for the child that is needed for each week.
- We ask that when possible the same parent or designated person drop-off and pick-up their child.
